I live all over Australia as well as Tasmania in open woodlands, forests, wetlands and the suburbs.


I eat small birds and sometimes I'll snack on an insect or two.

I am scared of people. I may get frightened and try to bite you if you come close to me! This would be dangerous because I am **venomous**, and my bite can make people very unwell.



I particularly like to live in forests and woodlands where eucalyptus and casuarina trees grow.


Check out my big strong bill! I use it to crack open honkey nuts, banksia cones and casuarina pods to eat the seeds inside.

After a bushfire, ill pop up all over the place but most of the time you'll find me scattered here and there around the bushland.


I am poisonous, I don't want anything to eat me!
